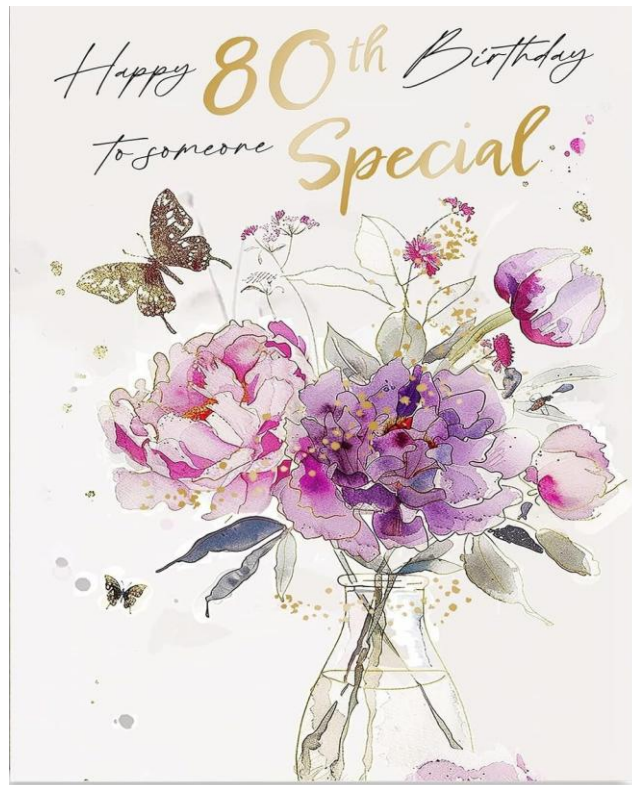

On the 20th September 2026, I will be taking on 'Only the Brave' supporting East Anglian Air Ambulance. It's a 6 mile run with a very muddy and challenging obstacle course thrown in!

East Anglian Air Ambulance receives no government funding and relies entirely on the support of the community.

They provide advanced critical care 24 hrs a day, 365 days a year to the most seriously ill and injured people in the region by air and road. Their crews are called to, on average 8 critical emergencies a day with each task costing in the region of £4, 250.
